2. be a graduating/graduated student from high school living in the USA with a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.6 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)
3. be completing their undergraduate degrees. The scholarship is not for those receiving a master's degree or a Ph.D.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Applicants will be selected based on the following:

1. Personal character
2. Financial need
3. Scholastic ability

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Candidates must submit the completed application packet (please see NOTE below) to the Mathrubhumi Scholarship Committee no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 31,2021 (postmarked). Please do not staple application materials.

NOTE: For an application to be deemed complete and considered by the Selection Committee, it must include the following:

2. A completed application form including a signed Information Release Form.
3. Typed essay (1-2 pages) listing all honors and awards you have received in high school and/or college, a description of your career goals, and any special personal or family circumstances affecting your need for financial assistance.
4. Official high school and/or college transcript.
5. SAT/ACT scores if you are a recent high school graduate.
6. A letter of recommendation from your academic dean, advisor, counselor/mentor, or teacher.

The Scholarship Selection Committee comprised of the trustees of the fund shall make the selection of each scholarship recipient by conducting interviews with shortlisted scholars and approve for fund disbursement. The scholarship disbursement shall be made available directly to the recipient. The aid must be utilized within one year of the date of the award and the proof should be submitted to Mathrubhumi.
